When people have limitations it can make them more vulnerable and this can lead others to control and abuse those individuals. You might have limitations but you don't lose your human rights to live without intimidation and abuse.



I'm smart and I know sometimes I express my frustration in inappropriate ways, but it doesn't give anyone the right to abuse me.

Helping to make this video and encouraging others to report offenders (like I have done) makes me feel like a true advocate and leading by my own example. This video gives me a way to say to others who are being intimidated or shamed by authority figures to stand up, share your experience and, most important, report them to their superiors!
